The above items need to be submitted to the Society by 5pm on October 21, 2016. Results will be announced before the end of Term 3. If your school is successful we would like to make the presentation at our AGM which is on October 28 at the Red Hill Community Hall. At this time we would ask that someone attends to accept the award and perhaps make a small visual presentation on the project.
